I, Jose Partida, do on oath make complaint, say and depose the following on this \_\_\_day of October, 2014: that I have substantial probable cause to believe and I do believe that I have cause to search:

All Subscriber information: All log files of account activity, validation of any and all Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, including all registration information, billing payment records, radius or Automatic Number Identification (ANI) information, subscriber, usage, Point of Presence (POP) information, email and other information including name, address, phone number, payment instrument information, billing statements, credit information, records of customer service for telephone number and other screen names that may tend to identify the user/ subscriber, of the IP address, or any other related information for the account and for the subscriber account of cellphone Serial #

Call Forwarding Records: All records which tend to identify the phone numbers to which calls are forwarded for the above described numbers for the period of time between the dates listed above including listed name and address, billing statement for the current cycle, records of customer service, credit information and dates of connection and/or disconnection of the telephone numbers identified, and any other telephone number in the chain of call forwarding.

### AFFIANT'S QUALIFICATIONS

- I am a peace officer employed by the Department of Consumer Affairs, Division of
   Investigation Health Quality Investigation Unit (HQIU), formerly the Medical Board of
   California ("MBC").
- 2. I have worked as an investigator for the HQIU / MBC since March 2013. Prior to being hired by MBC, I worked for 4 ½ years as a Parole Agent for the State of California. Prior to being a Parole Agent I worked for 8 years as a Detentions Deputy Sheriff for the San Diego County Sheriff's Department. I also worked as a Corrections Deputy Probation Officer for almost 3 years. I obtained a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from National University in 2005.
- 3. My training as a Medical Board investigator includes passing a CA P.O.S.T. 17 week
  Specialized Investigator Basic Course Academy at Goldenwest College in Huntington
  Beach, where I was awarded the Excellence in Report Writing Award, Academic Award,
  and Character Award. I also completed four months of field training under the tutelage of a
  senior field training officer. I have also received several hours of additional training and
  ongoing education, in fulfillment of California POST requirements, in the following areas:
  interview and interrogation, field training officer, first aid/CPR, tactical firearms, pain
  management, tactical communications, arrest and control, blood borne pathogens and safe

methods of evidence handling, alternative medicine, unlicensed practice, and the impaired physician.

4. As a Medical Board investigator, I have handled a wide variety of cases, including negligent or incompetent care by physicians, criminal violations by physicians, fraud cases, dishonesty, unlicensed practice, sexual misconduct, physicians with physical impairments or impairments caused by drug or alcohol abuse, etc. I have testified in administrative and criminal courts of law, and have worked closely with other law enforcement agencies on complex cases. As part of my regular duties, I investigate complaints received by the Medical Board of California. This includes, but is not limited to, interviewing witnesses and physicians, preparing investigative reports and testifying in court.

#### PROBABLE CAUSE

During the course of my duties, I have learned the following information based upon my ongoing investigation. All references to dates refer to the current calendar year unless otherwise stated.

On January 4, 2014, victim Y.D. went to go see Dr. Jeffrey Abrams for pain in her belly button. During the examination Dr. Abrams asked Y.D. to remove her clothes. Dr. Abrams watched Y.D. as she removed her outer clothing. Dr. Abrams then told Y.D. to remove all of her clothes. Y.D. complied and was standing completely naked in front of Dr. Abrams. Y.D. laid down on the examination table and Dr. Abrams approached her to continue the examination. Dr. Abrams inserted a gloved finger inside Y.D.'s vagina. Once inside Y.D.'s vagina Dr. Abrams moved his finger in what appeared to be a circular motion and asked Y.D. "You have pain?" Y.D. replied, "No." Dr. Abrams removed his finger from Y.D.'s vagina. Dr. Abrams asked Y.D. to turn around. Y.D. turned her back to Dr. Abrams. Y.D. felt Dr. Abrams insert a gloved finger inside her vagina. Once inside Y.D.'s vagina Dr. Abrams moved his finger in what appeared to be a circular motion and asked Y.D. "you have pain?" Y.D. replied, "No." Dr. Abrams removed his finger from Y.D.'s vagina. Dr. Abrams removed his finger from Y.D. by vagina. Dr. Abrams asked Y.D. to stand up. Y.D. was still naked and stood up

to face Dr. Abrams. Y.D. used her hair to cover up her breasts as much as possible. Y.D. saw Dr. Abrams reach into the right pocket of his white coat. Dr. Abrams removed what appeared to be a cellphone. Dr. Abrams walked up to Y.D. and took a close-up picture of Y.D.'s abdomen area near her belly button. Dr. Abrams then walked up to Y.D. and used both his hands to push Y.D.'s hair away from her breasts and behind her shoulders to expose her breast. Dr. Abrams then grabbed both of Y.D.'s forearms with his hands and placed Y.D.'s arms to her side. Dr. Abrams told Y.D. to stand this way. Y.D. believes Dr. Abrams took about 5 total photos of her.

Medical Board Expert Reviewer Dr. David Geffner reviewed the limited medical records of Y.D. and her statement. Dr. Geffner determined the examination and the photos of Y.D. were extreme departures from the standard of care.

On July 3, 2014, a search warrant was executed on Dr. Abrams, his property, and the Volunteers in Medicine Clinic located in El Cajon, CA. During the execution of the search warrant I retrieved a cell phone described as a black HTC ADR 6350 Droid Incredible 2 (Android); Serial # HT19SMA00901from Dr. Abrams rear pants pocket. I asked Dr. Abrams if the cell phone was his personal cell phone or his work cell phone. Dr. Abrams stated the cell phone was his "work" cell phone. A search of the cell phone revealed an excess of 1300 photos. The photos were of numerous females in an exam room. The females were either completely nude or partially nude. Some photos were of female's vaginas, breasts, and buttocks. The photos of Y.D. were located on this cell phone. There was also a photo of a very young girl whose vagina, breast, and buttock were exposed. The phone also contained a video of a female patient, later identified as R.Y. masturbating in the exam room with Dr. Abrams.

Through the investigation I was able to identify some of the additional females in the photographs and conducted interviews with them. Some females were aware of Dr. Abrams taking photos of them while they were nude. One female was not aware that Dr. Abrams took a photo of her while she was nude.

Medical Board Expert Reviewer Dr. David Geffner reviewed the evidence obtained, the medical records of the identified victims, and their statements. Dr. Geffner determined the

important circumstantial evidence that Dr. Abrams is responsible for these crimes of Sexual Penetration of an Unconscious Person and Sexual Battery of an Unconscious Person.

I believe that by securing the requested information for the time periods listed I will be able to collect sufficient evidence to establish dominion and control by Dr. Abrams in the criminal activity described above while limiting the request to a reasonable time frame.

I have represented to the custodians of Verizon Wireless that I will execute the search warrants by facsimile transmission to their addresses described above, and will under no circumstances engage in a forcible entry of the business premises. Although the headquarters of Verizon Wireless is located outside San Diego County, the company is doing business within San Diego County. I believe Penal Code section 1524.2 provides a basis for this court to order the records delivered.

I also know from my experience that it is common for telephone number accounts to be sold by one company to another company or individual. I also know a single account can be sold numerous times. Often telephone companies will not release information regarding the sale of an account absent a court order.

#### **DEFERRED NOTICE REQUEST**

I have also consulted with Deputy District Attorney Kerry Conway of the San Diego District Attorney's Office. She has advised me the California Public Utilities Commission has directed that Verizon Wireless must notify the subscriber(s) that a search warrant was received, and provide the subscriber(s) with the name of the agency making the request. She also told me, and I was aware independently, the required notification will be deferred and no disclosure made pending further court order if there is a certification for non-disclosure in the body of the warrant setting forth a statement that there is probable cause to believe that notification to the subscriber(s) would impede the investigation of the offense pursuant to which the warrant was issued. Accordingly, I do so believe and state it is my opinion such notification would seriously impede the subject investigation for the following reasons:

Based on my training and experience, I believe that notification of the subscriber(s) in this case, under all the facts set forth in the affidavit, would cause the suspect herein to hide or move his activity, or change telephone numbers, and/or flee, which would not only impede but would more likely destroy the investigation herein. I therefore request the court order the subject utility to **defer notification** pending further Court Order.

Therefore, based on my training and experience and the above facts, I believe that I have substantial cause to believe the above described information, or a portion thereof, will be at the above described premises when the warrant is served.

Based on the aforementioned information and investigation, I believe that grounds for the issuance of a search warrant exist as set forth in Penal Code 1524.

I, the affiant, hereby pray that a search warrant be issued for the seizure of said property, or any part thereof, from said premise, good cause being shown therefore, and that the same be brought before this magistrate or retained subject to the order of this Court.
